2026/ 2 99 County Councillor Philip Kidney report

Cllr Kidney reported that a proposal at the recent County Council meeting was a 4.6% increase in Council Tax for the next financial year 2026-27, with a 5% increase proposal for 27/28. No update on the Active Travel project, residents invited to a forum at various locations in the County, one to be held at the De-valance Tenby 5th March. Reports received on fly tipping on land opposite Penally Camp, enforcement officers investigating, a reminder that those found to be fly tipping will be prosecuted. Compound fencing will remain in place at a property in Holloway Court for competition of works. PCC to employ two new Environmental enforcement officers in the area. On the matter of erosion on the South Beach, Penally Community Council to raise concerns with Tenby Golf Club.

Cllr Walsh reported that concerns have been raised on the condition of the footpath alongside the playing field, Cllr Kidney to report to Pembrokeshire County Council concerns on slippery path, large pools of water and the hedge and verge overgrown.
