2025/10 60 Consider Planning applications

25/0482/PA THE BUNGALOW, Penally Manor, PENALLY, Tenby, Pembrokeshire, SA70 7PZ, Demolition of existing dwelling and replacement with a new dwelling. Following consideration of the information presented by the Planning Authority; Councillor Richards proposed that Penally Community Council object to the application, previous access concerns raised by the Highways department still applicable, a very narrow lane not passable with public service vehicles i.e. waste and emergency services, over development of the site, further concern on the correct post code being attached to the application, Councillor Walsh seconded the proposal, and all councillors In agreement.

The Clerk reported an email received from Cllr Parkinson, thanking Cllrs for there support but would be standing down as Cllr, Cllr Richards would like to thank Cllr Parkinson for her time as a Cllr, the Clerk to respond.

2025/10 64 County Councillor Philip Kidney report

Cllr Kidney reported that the County Council will be reviewing the second homes tax at this week's meeting. The Brynhir development progressing, preparatory work to commence in November. Feedback to be sent to Cllr Kidney in relation to the recent Ironman event. Welsh Government have opened a grant toward Hospitality and Tourism relating to outdoor events, a link to follow. Continuous problems with general household waste being deposited in public bins, further warning that the bins will be removed if it continues. A warning from the local authority that QR codes are being falsely displayed on parking meters encouraging payment, the public advised not to use QR Codes displayed as it's a scam.
